Criteria for Memorial Scholarship Award

The NJCC Memorial Scholarship Award was established in 2001 to recognize and honor all NJCC members who have made significant contributions to the NJCC and have subsequently passed away. The NJCC does not recommend or select individual candidates for these awards, but requests that the institution receiving the award select a candidate based upon the following criteria:

Candidates should:

- Be enrolled in, or actively planning to be enrolled in, computer related training at a recognized institution of higher learning, and show promise of successfully completing that training.
- Show promise that they will put the award to good use, making future contributions to the field, in the generous spirit of the founders for whom the award was instituted.
- Have a demonstrated need to upgrade their job skills or further their education.
- Have demonstrated financial need.
- Be from New Jersey.

The awards are given on a non-discriminatory, equal opportunity basis.

The award will be given to an institution that is nominated by a member of the NJCC and approved by both the NJCC Executive Committee and the NJCC membership. The award recipient will be chosen by that institution, honoring the NJCC criteria above. The institution will be responsible for all administration related to the award.

Recipients along with a representative of the selected institution are requested (but not required) to attend a NJCC meeting to receive the award. Our meetings are normally held at the North Branch Reformed Church in Bridgewater, NJ, on the second Wednesday evening of each month (except July and August). Some acknowledgement, such as a letter to the NJCC, is required before the award is dispensed.
