- A motion was made, seconded and passed to approve all Minutes and Treasurer’s Reports as currently posted on our NJCC website. John O’Neill was thanked for his continued service as our NJCC Treasurer.
- Doris Smith, NJCC Chairperson presented a \$500, 2004 NJCC Memorial Award to Philip Palma of Union County College. Ms. Louise Yohalem, Executive Director of the Union County College Foundation, also attended and gave an excellent summary of UCC, the award selection process, and why Philip was selected for our award.

John Beck, NJCC 2nd Vice-President, then did an excellent presentation on Windows XP Movie Maker. He explained video capture; importing video, audio, or music; how to use video effects and transitions; making titles or credits; making and finishing the movie; and then saving it to your computer or a CD, or sending it via email or to a DV camera. John also did a short presentation on Nero 6 Ultra Edition, an all-in-one digital media solution including video, audio, and CD burning features.
